Led by Professors Tom MacDonald and Isla Mackenzie, MEMO Research has delivered high quality research for over 20 years.

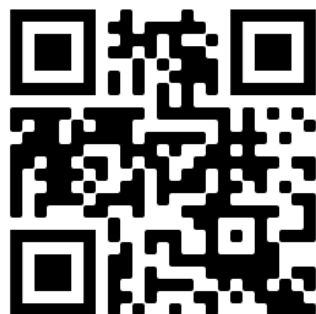
